



Bright Fancy Sergina

ApHC Hall of Fame—Production

Though Bright Fancy Sergina now resides in Pilot Point, Texas, she was foaled in Italy, making her a special addition to La Pavarana Show Horses. Proprietor Marco Bertazzoni found her in 2000 and imported her to the United States in 2003.

“I was looking for a broodmare pack,” Marco explains. “I knew there was a Dreamfinder full sister in Italy. That’s why I found the mare. She was part of the first pack I bought in Italy.” Bright Fancy Sergina’s dam, Justa Figment, was indeed a full sister to the famous Dreamfinder (sired by Alias King and out of Aztecs Fancy Frani, AQHA).

Justa Figment had been bred to Jay Mighty Bright, and the resulting filly is now a special part of Marco’s broodmare band. Marco had Steve Cruse, also of Pilot Point, campaign the mare in 2004 and she accumulated 47.5 halter points during her short career.

Bright Fancy Sergina’s first two foals, Dream Brightfinder and Might O Dreams, are sired by King-O’-Dreams and foaled in 2002 and 2003, respectively. Her next five foals are the horses that went on to spectacular show careers that saw their dam inducted into the Hall of Fame.

The mare produced Brightfancy Playgirl, sired by Playgirls Conclusion (AQHA), in 2005, and an embryo transfer mare foaled Fancy Clusified, sired by Kid Clusified (AQHA) that same year. Both fillies were stellar halter mares. “Brightfancy Playgirl,” Marco says, “was my first World champion, shown as a weanling.”

Brightfancy Playgirl earned 116.5 lifetime halter points, a register of merit (ROM) and a superior at halter award, earning her bronze medallion as a yearling. Fancy Clusified earned 146 lifetime halter points, a ROM and superior at halter as well, and was awarded her bronze medallion as a 2 year old.

Bright Fancy Sergina’s 2006 foal, Hear The Cheers, was sired by Hear The Cheers (AQHA) and has earned 23.5 lifetime halter points in a short career and was awarded his bronze medallion as a weanling for his National championship in weanling geldings.

Its Top Secret, sired by The Top Secret (AQHA), followed in 2007 and has 96 lifetime points. The mare also earned a ROM and her bronze medallion as a 2 year old. The Top Secret Dream, also sired by The Top Secret, has earned 162.5 lifetime points, her ROM and superior at halter award, and earned her bronze medallion as a yearling.

With such impressive siblings, the mare’s 2009 filly, Sheza Bright Touch, sired by TD In Three (AQHA) might expand her mother’s impressive production record. Marco plans to give Bright Fancy Sergina a year of rest, then select another favored stallion for her next foal.

“Despite not coming from a ‘modern’ bloodline, she’s really modern looking,” Marco says of the mare. “She has a large coup and a real strong back, which is probably her best quality.”
