

Albe Exclusive (via production record) ApHC Hall of Fame



Albe Exclusive has produced five different bronze medallion-winning horses which earns her a Supreme Dam Production Plaque and an automatic induction into the ApHC Hall of Fame (HOF).

Foaled in 1996, Albe Exclusive descends from the Hall of Fame bloodlines of Hayes' Roman Cloud and Bright Eyes Brother. By Legend Bright and out of Exclusive's Double (JC), she was bred, raised and is still owned by Lewis and Marilyn Feuerstein of the Three Creeks

Ranch in Creston, California. Her eight registered foals have, so far, accumulated 40.5 performance points, over 400 halter points, seven Registers of Merit (ROMs) and a very impressive 12 bronze medallions.

Four of the five foals qualifying her for the Hall of Fame are sired by Hall of Fame stallion, Always Dignified: Way Exclusive, a 2004 gelding with eight bronze halter medallions, two year-

end top tens, three ROMs in halter geldings and 174 points combined in open, non-pro and youth; Way Elegant, a 2003 mare with an ROM in halter mares, a bronze medallion in three-year-old mares and a year-end top ten; Way Allusive, a 2005 mare with two Superior Events in halter, three ROMs in halter mares, three year-end top tens and a 2008 bronze medallion in three-year-old mares; The 2010 gelding, A Way, who is off to a great start with an ROM and a bronze medallion in two-year-old geldings from 2012.

The other foal qualifying her is the 2000 gelding, Exclusively Roman, sired by Charlie Cloud. He has a bronze medallion in pre-green hunter; ROMs in youth hunter in hand geldings, hunter under saddle 18 & under, senior hunter under saddle, hunter in hand stallions and non-pro hunter under saddle; year-end top 10 in three-year-old snaffle bit hunter under saddle; and three ACAAP year-end top tens in western riding, showmanship and English equitation.

With so many successes in events varying from halter to hunter under saddle to western riding, and in all divisions from open to youth, Albe Exclusive's produce have amply proven her versatility as a broodmare and demonstrated her Hall of Fame-worthy contributions to the breed.
