



Bar Gill

Bill and JoAnn Robinson of Pleasant Grove, Utah, bred, owned and raced Bar Gill, a 1966 stallion by Mr. Tonto Bars (AQHA) and out of J & B's Spotted Fawn. During his first two years on the track, the stallion started in 13 races, winning 11.

Bar Gill raced against the biggest names in Appaloosa racing during the '60s: Ledge Deck, Mr. Big Wig, My Host Bright and Ocala Light; he defeated each at least once in his career. He accumulated seven straight wins leading to the 1968 World Wide Futurity.

The stallion sired 168 registered foals, including 56 that made it to the track and others that did well in the performance arena. His racing offspring earned \$104,937 and from 1980–1995 he ranked fourth on the list of leading broodmare sires of register of merit earners, behind only Scooter Bug G., Bolodier (JC) and Easy Jet (QH).

Notable offspring include Bar Supreme, Champ Bar, Hopscotch Reed, Pacific Bar Gill and Running Bear DD.
