Faults		
Knockdown 4 faults per knockdown	Third disobedience anywhere on course	In the case of clean round ties for first place or in the case of ties for point-earning placings, a jump-off shall be held. The height and spread of at least 50% of the obstacles shall be increased not less than 3 and not more than 6 inches in height and to a maximum spread of 5 feet for open classes and 4 feet for youth and non-pro classes. In case of ties involving faults, rails shall not be raised. Jump-offs must be timed. The horse with the least number of faults shall be the winner. The winner will be decided on time only if faults are equal.
Disobedience:	Failure of the entry to cross starting line within one minute after an audible signal to proceed is given	
First disobedience anywhere on course 4 faults	Fall of horse and/or exhibitor	
Second disobedience anywhere on course 4 faults	Failure to complete course, off course	
	Deliberately addressing an obstacle	

Height of Fences	Broken Equipment
Open: Minimum 3 feet - 6 inches (3' 6")	In case of broken equipment, the exhibitor may either continue without penalty or stop and correct difficulty, in which case he will be penalized 3 faults. In case of loss of shoe, exhibitor may continue without penalty or be eliminated.
Preliminary: Minimum 3 feet (3'), Maximum 3 feet - 9 inches (3' 9")	
Youth & Non-Pro: Minimum 3 feet - 3 inches (3' 3"), Maximum 3 feet - 6 inches (3' 6")
